VINEYARDS

The grapes were harvested at optimal ripeness, ensuring a balance of rich fruit flavors and structured tannins. After careful sorting, the grapes underwent fermentation in stainless steel tanks, where temperature control was key to extracting deep color, robust flavors, and maintaining the integrity of the fruit. Post-fermentation, the wine underwent malolactic fermentation to soften the acidity and enhance the silky texture, adding complexity to the palate. The Cabernet Sauvignon was aged in a mix of French and American oak barrels. This strategic use of oak aimed to imbue the wine with subtle notes of vanilla and spice while respecting the varietal's bold fruit characteristics. The aging process was carefully monitored to ensure a harmonious integration of oak flavors, contributing to the wine's overall balance and elegance. The result is a well-rounded 2023 Cabernet Sauvignon from Paso Robles, showcasing the region's capacity to produce full-bodied wines with rich flavors and a smooth finish, suitable for aging or immediate enjoyment.

WINE

The 2023 Cabernet Sauvignon from Paso Robles is a robust and elegantly structured wine that showcases the rich terroir of this dynamic California region. It features a deep, dark garnet color, indicative of its concentrated flavors. On the nose, this Cabernet Sauvignon offers a complex bouquet of dark cherries and ripe blackcurrants, enriched by undertones of eucalyptus and a hint of leather, adding layers of depth and sophistication. The palate is full-bodied and rich, with a velvety texture that carries the intense flavors of blackberry and plum, seamlessly integrated with notes of dark chocolate and a touch of spice from careful oak aging. The tannins are firm yet polished, providing a solid backbone that leads to a long, lingering finish with a pleasing hint of vanilla and toasted oak. This 2023 Paso Robles Cabernet Sauvignon is a testament to the region's ability to produce powerful yet balanced wines, ideal for pairing with hearty meat dishes or for enjoying on its own as a standout example of local viticulture.
